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A Photographers Guide To Focus

Focus is a combination of lens aperture and light. Photo by: 'Unsplash'. Smaller apertures, such as f/8 to f/16, will "force" all the light coming from outside to pass through a tiny hole and concentrate on the image sensor. As a result, a bigger part of the image will be in focus.

The aperture is the preferred setting to set first, as it directly influences how much of your scene is in focus. But, if you are looking to create motion blur, then it is second to the shutter speed. Exposure will be much easier if you can memorize the f/stop scale. The scale is as follows: f/1.4, f/2, f/2.8, f/4, f/5.6, f/8, f/11, f/16, f/22.

However, with focus stacking, images are captured with different focus points and later combined in Photoshop; this is in order to create an image with more DOF than would be possible with a single exposure.

How to photograph images for Focus Stacking. For creating focus stacked images, photograph at least three frames. In one frame, the foreground should be in focus; in the second frame, the middle area should be in focus, and in the third frame, the background should be in focus.

A useful technique often use in landscape, insect and product photography. focus stacking involves 'stacking' together images to achieve a larger focal length than that possible in a single image. When you use a wide aperture (say f/1.4), the focal length is at its minimum, and as a result covers just a small part of an object.
