Classifying Sentences. Classifying sentences is easiest if you mark the parts and then see what you have. Underline independent clauses once. Underline dependent clauses twice. 1 independent = simple. 2 independent = compound. 1 independent and 1 (or more) dependent = complex. 2 (or more) independent and 1 (or more) dependent = compound-complex. We might go to New Orleans on our Christmas vacation or to New York next spring.

Classifying Sentences - English Grammar 101

The following statements are true about sentences in English: A new sentence begins with a capital letter. He obtained his degree. A sentence ends with punctuation (a period, a question mark, or an exclamation point). He obtained his degree. A sentence contains a subject that is only given once. Smith he obtained his degree.

Classifying Sentences According to Structure Quiz - Quizizz

A complex sentence contains a subordinate clause and an independent clause. A subordinate clause is a group of words that has a subject and a verb but does not express a complete thought. Here's a sentence diagram of a complex sentence. Note that there are still two horizontal lines, but one of them is below the other and moved to the right.
